## Osteoporosis (DEXA Screening) Protocol

## **Diagnosis/Chief Complaint**

Eligible populations:

Adults Ages 50-65 plus

Patients at risk for osteoporosis

Patients requiring therapy to reduce high risk of non-traumatic fractures

### Lab Evaluations/Results

## **Diagnostic Evaluation/Results**

Perform bone mineral density (BMD) testing using DEXA for:

- White women ≥ 65 years regardless of risk factors
- Men/women with fracture risk (10-year probability of fracture using FRAX of 9.3%)
- On corticosteroids
- Transplant

#### **Plan of Care**

#### **SPECIAL ATTENTION:**

Calculate FRAX (http://www.shef.ac.uk/FRAX/index.aspx) to assess future fracture risk and to identify patients for BMD testing. Record result.

Note: Order a DEXA scan on women 67 or older who have had a fracture within 6 months of the event, if not performed earlier or on bisphosphonate therapy. Excludes fingers, toes, face or skull fractures. Consider oral bisphosphonate therapy. A drug holiday may be considered after 3-5 years.
